
Collective Bargaining in the U.S. 集体协商谈判在美国

- Established in 1935 by the National Labor Relations Act 1935年在劳动关系法中建立
- Based on the premise of "exclusive representation" 在"唯一代表"为基础的前提下
- Every year, some 30,000 collective bargaining agreements are negotiated in the U.S.

- About 8 million private-sector workers and 8.5 million publicsector workers are covered by collective bargaining agreements






